



OPEN HOUSES

Let us know what you think about possible improvements for I-35!

The Texas Department of Transportation, City of Austin, and Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization are partnering with other transportation agencies and the public to identify short- and mid-term strategies to improve I-35 through the metropolitan area.

Earlier this Spring, we held a series of live open houses and a virtual open house to collect feedback on several preliminary concepts for I-35 between SH 45 N and SH 45 SE. We received nearly 340 comments during the comment period, and have used this input and additional technical analysis to further refine the concepts.

Later this month, we will be presenting the refined concepts to the public at another round of open houses. We want to make sure that they reflect what you, as a community, would like to see implemented in Travis County. The concepts range from broad proposals for adding mainlane capacity to I-35, including potentially reconstructing portions of I-35 downtown to modify the existing lanes or fully depress all lanes, to ramp and auxiliary lane improvements, a Texas Super Street concept, turnaround lanes, bicycle and pedestrian improvements, and other ways of addressing the transportation needs along and across I-35. Maps showing improvement concepts along I-35 will also be presented for feedback.
